ABM PEW REFLECTIONS

The Orthodox Church describes Mary Magdalene as 'Equal to the Apostles' or the 'Apostle to the Apostles' because she was the one who told Peter and John that the Lord had risen from the dead. There is an Akathist (a very long hymn with many long verses) which tells about her post-Resurrection role: Rejoice, you who saw the true Gardener risen from the dead before all others!

Rejoice, you who now live in the garden of heaven!

Rejoice, you who first received tidings of the resurrection from the lips of Christ!

Rejoice, you who first announced the words of joy to the apostles!

Rejoice, O holy Mary Magdalene, equal of the apostles, who loved the sweetest Lord Jesus more than all good things!

- Give thanks for all who, like Mary Magdalene, love our sweet Lord above all the good things the world has to offer.
- Give thanks for the Hong Kong Sheng Kung Hui, the Anglican Church of Hong Kong, remembering their work and witness.
